<u>Final Project/Thesis, Dissertation Requirements (including English Proficiency)</u> for Final Semester Students

Basis:

- a. Rector's Regulation Number 9 of 2020 concerning Academic Regulations for Undergraduate Education Programs (S-1) at UPN "Veteran" East Java;
- b. Rector's Regulation Number 03 of 2019 concerning Guidelines for Master's Education Programs at UPN "Veteran" East Java;
- c. Rector's Regulation Number 11 of 2020 concerning Guidelines for Doctoral Education Programs Based on Coursework at UPN "Veteran" East Java;
- d. Rector's Decree Number 56/UN63/TU/2023 concerning the UPN "Veteran East Java Academic Calendar for the 2023/2024 Academic Year;
- e. English Proficiency Test Guidelines by the Language Academic Support Unit.
- 2. In relation to the aforementioned, Study Programs/Departments/Faculties are required to:
- a. Arrange final project/thesis, dissertation exam schedules according to the UPN "Veteran" East Java academic calendar.
- b. Determine the requirements for taking final projects/theses, dissertations and implement them in an orderly and directed manner.
- c. Monitor the implementation of final project completion and its requirements so that students can take part in graduation ceremonies according to the predetermined schedule.
- 3. Regarding point 1e in the basis above, as part of the requirements for completing the Final Project/Thesis, Thesis, Dissertation, the Study Program/Department/Faculty needs to pay attention to and implement that:
- a. English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL 450 is a requirement for Undergraduate Program students to take a final thesis project;

b.English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL 450 is an academic requirement for prospective Master's program students and making English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL 475 a requirement for Master's program students to take the Thesis exam;

c. English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL 500 is an academic requirement for prospective doctoral students and is a requirement for Doctoral Program students to take the Closed Dissertation exam.
